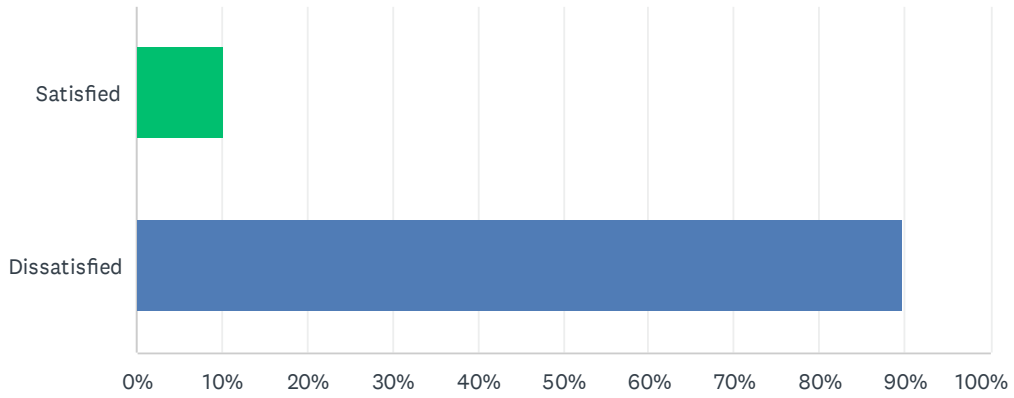


Q1 Eagle officials listen and make decisions based on citizen input.

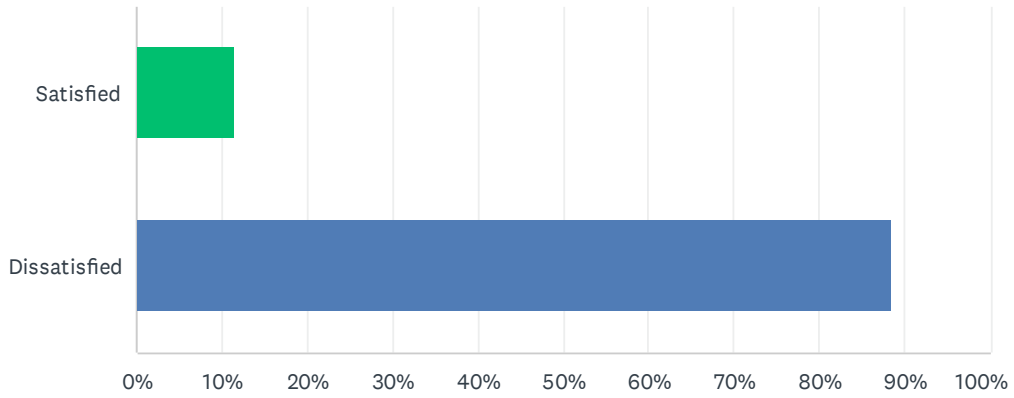

Q2 The direction Eagle has taken in the past four years.

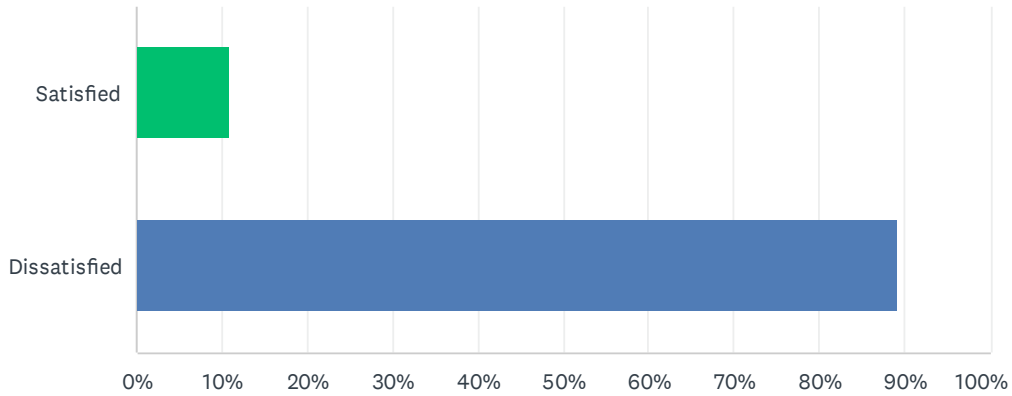

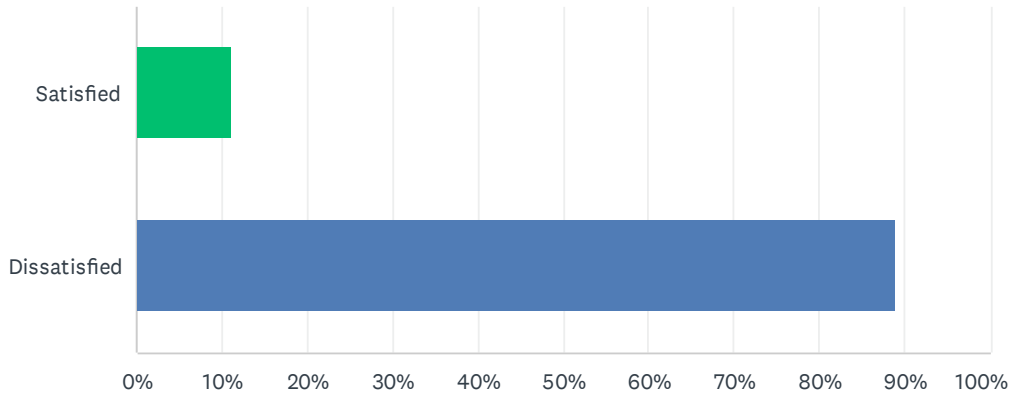

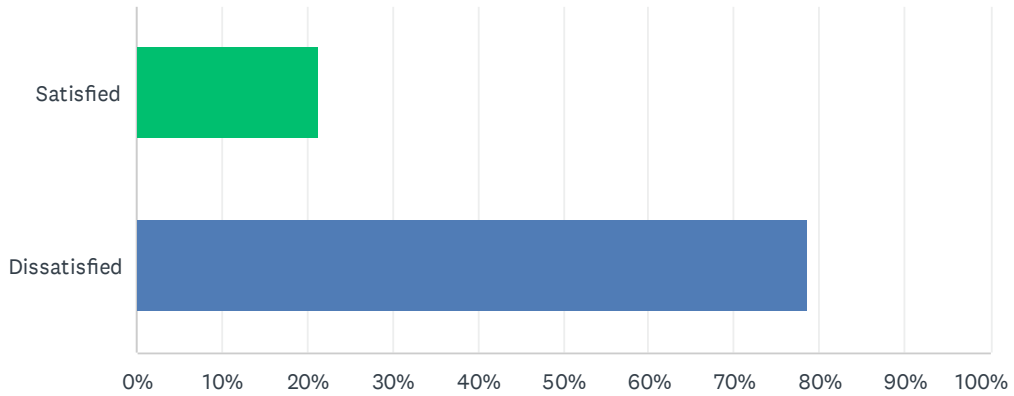

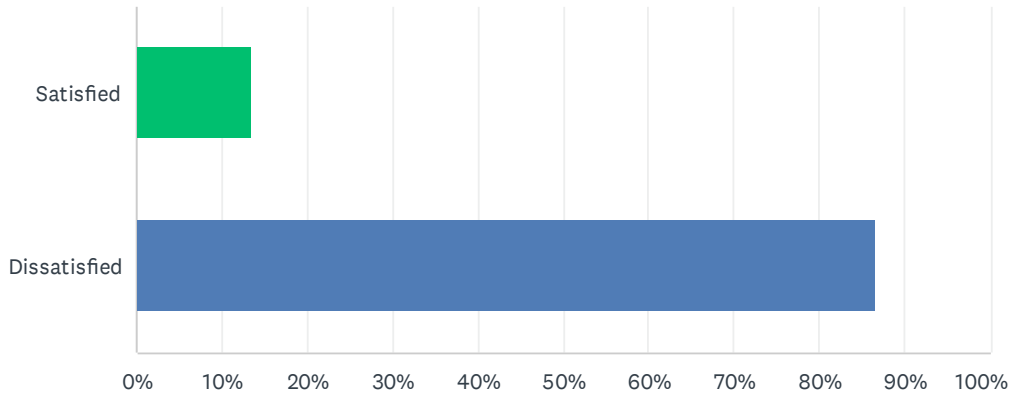

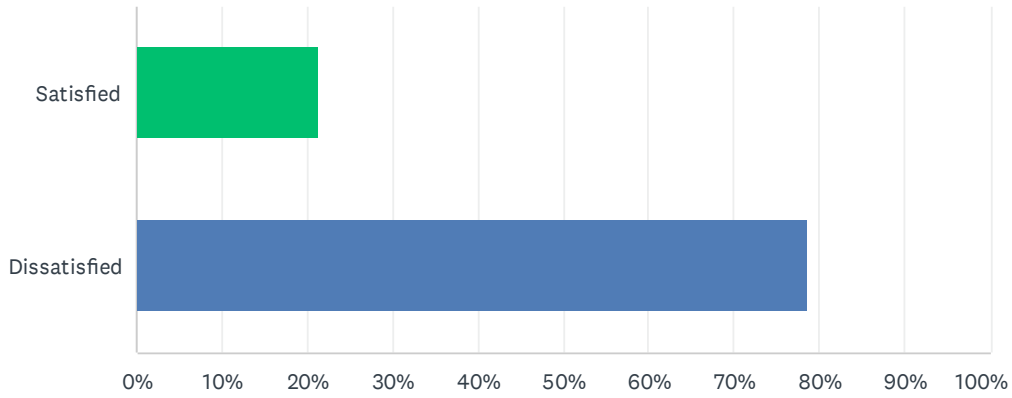

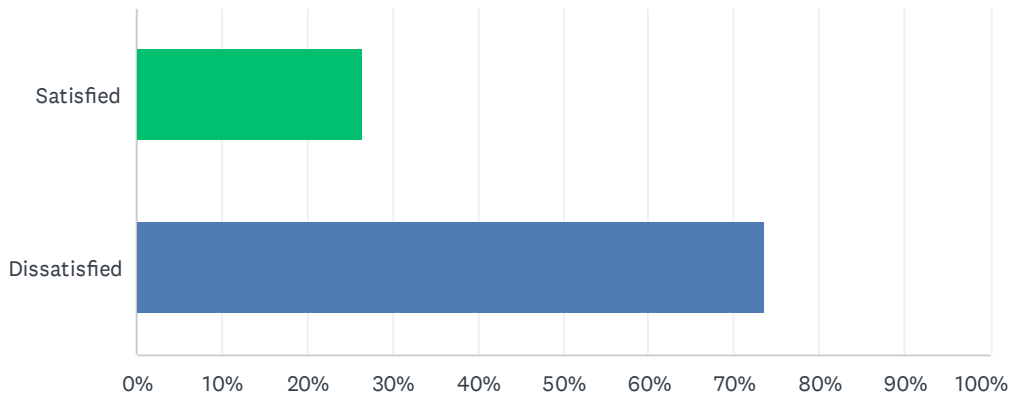

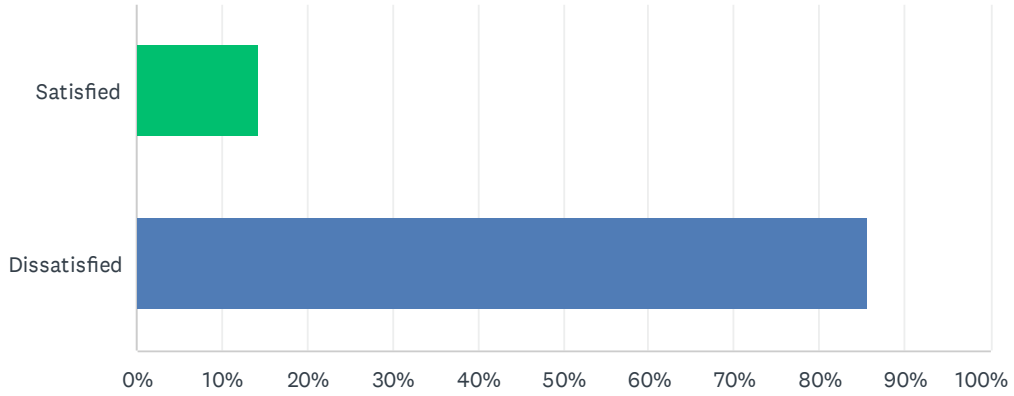

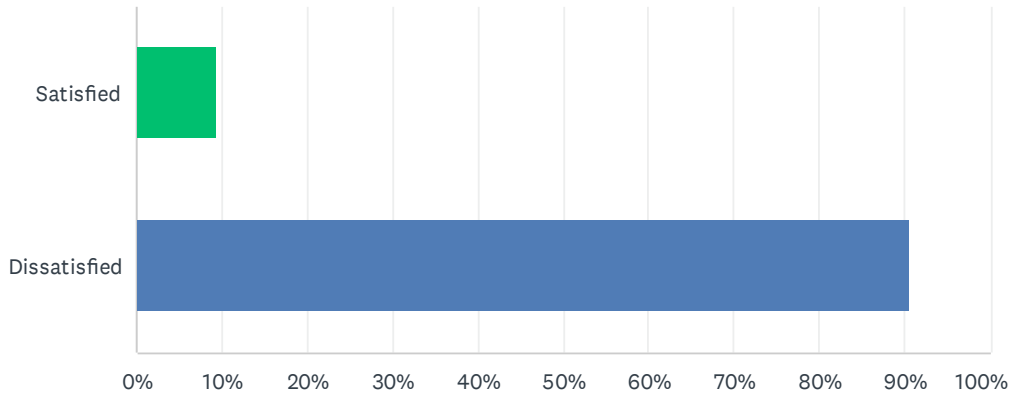

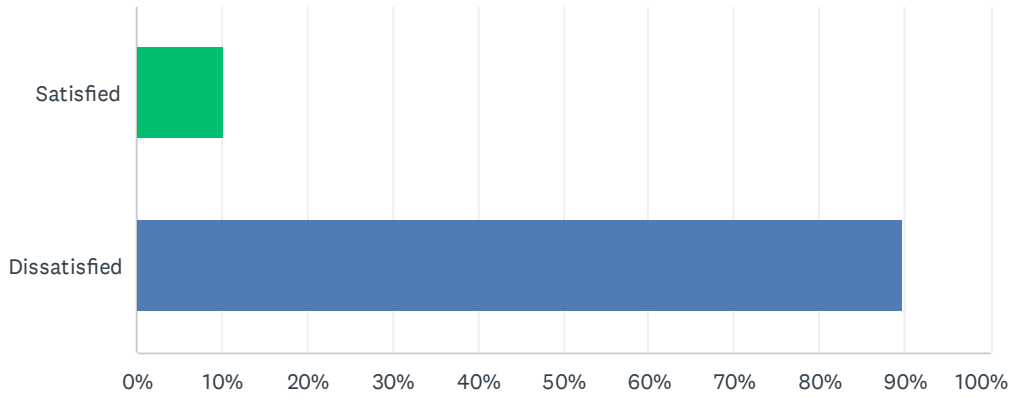

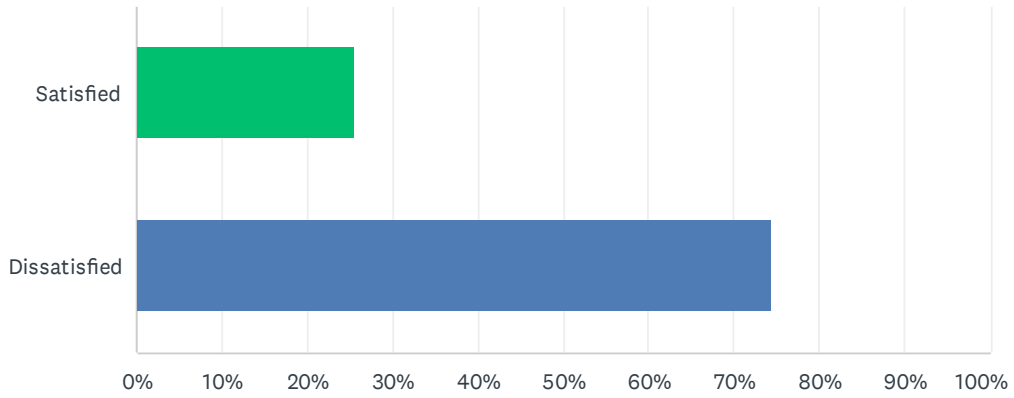

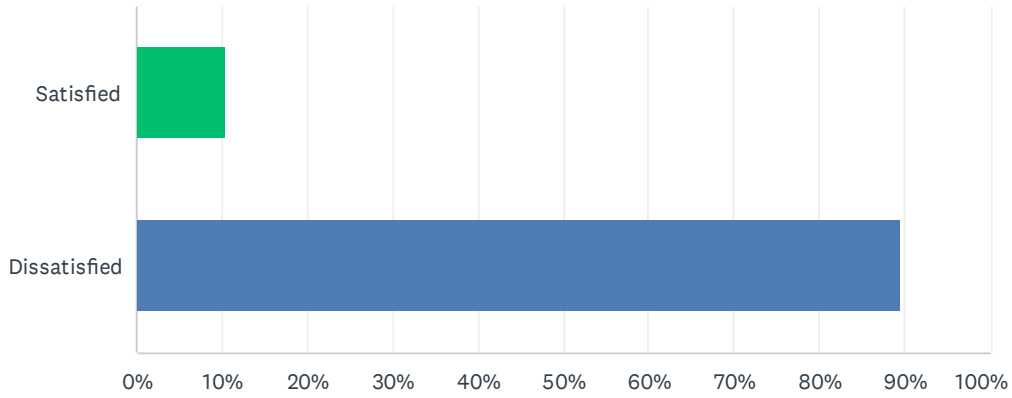

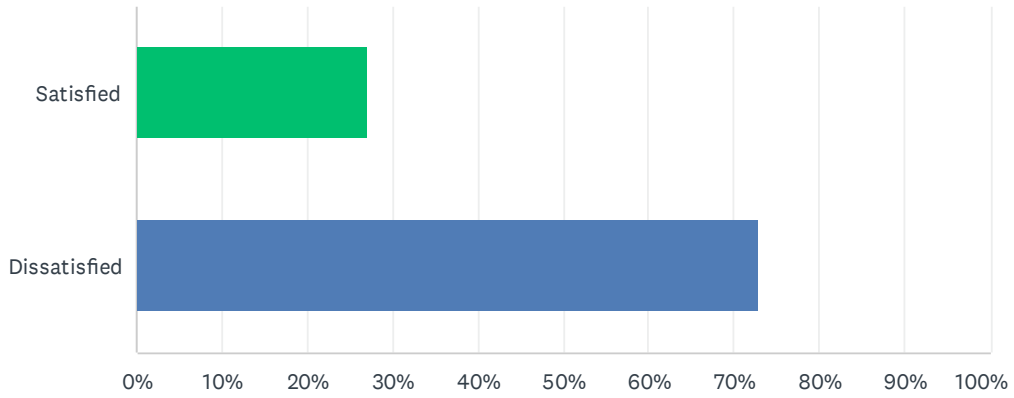

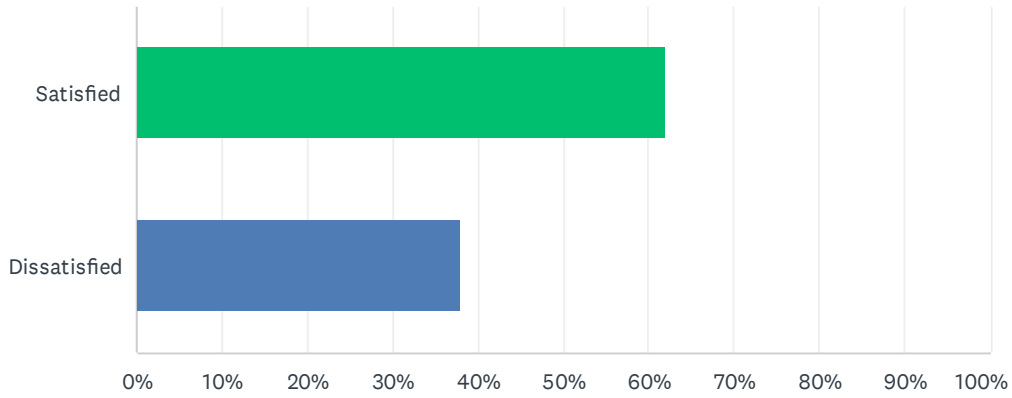

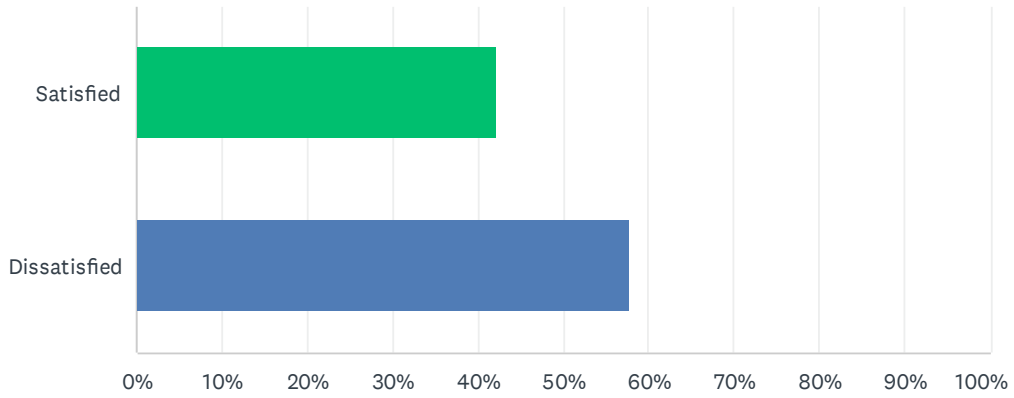

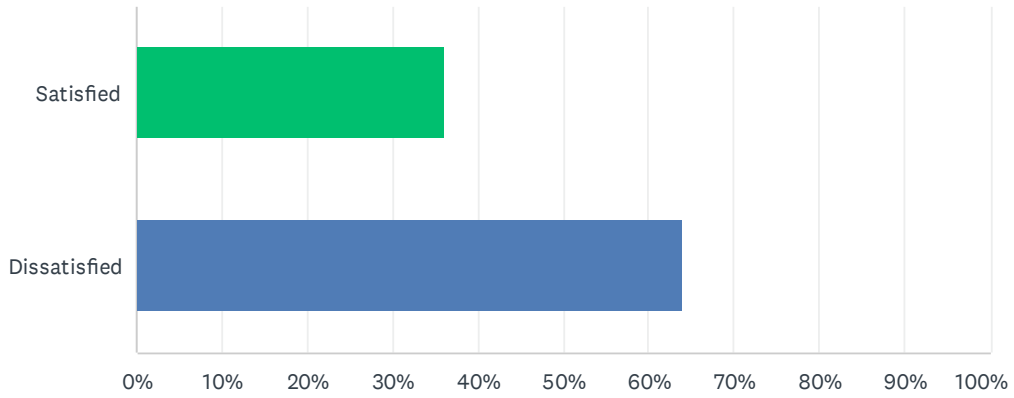

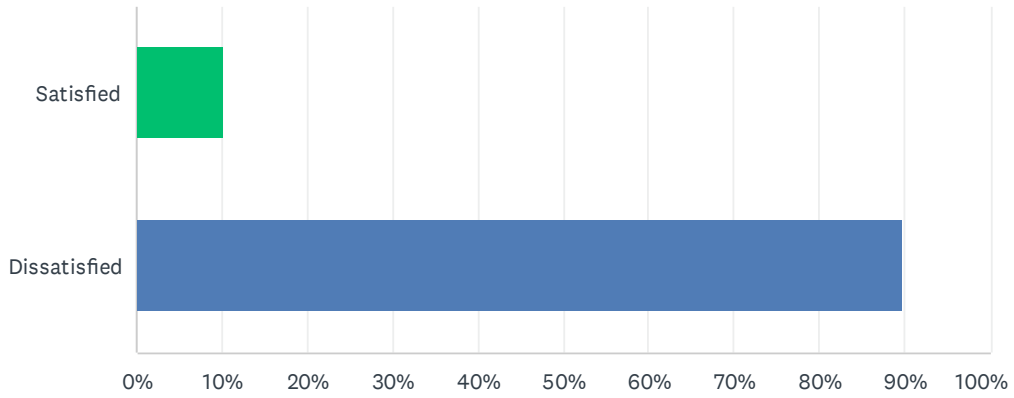

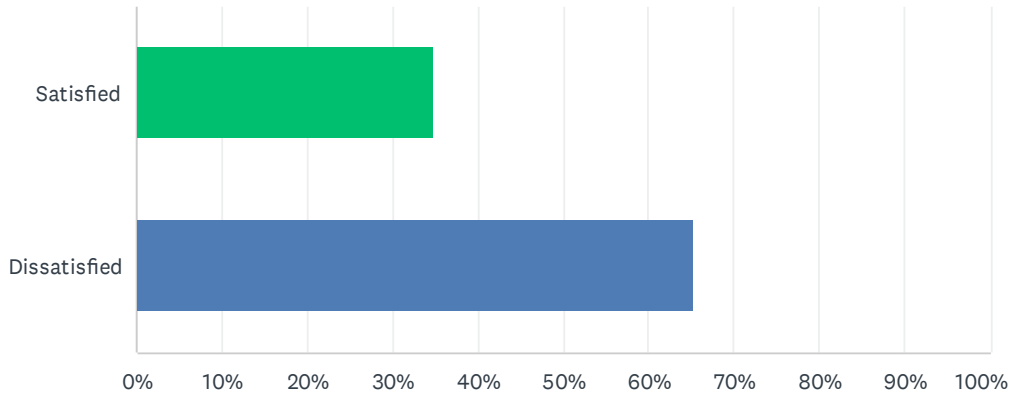

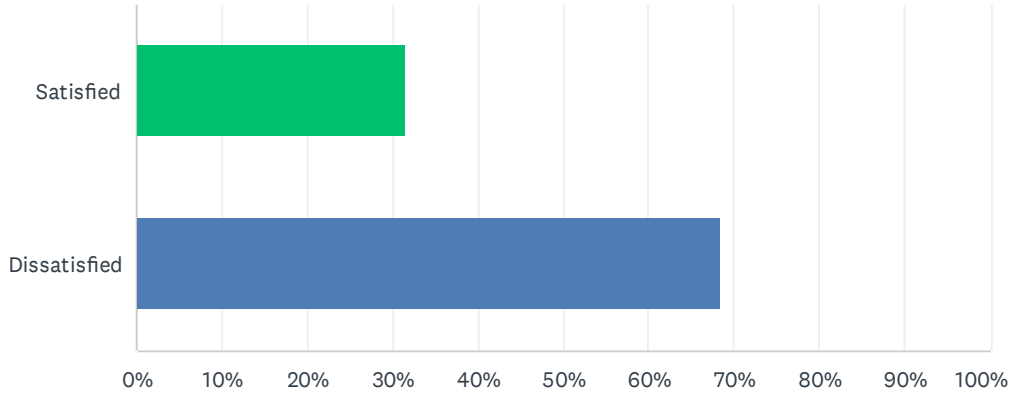

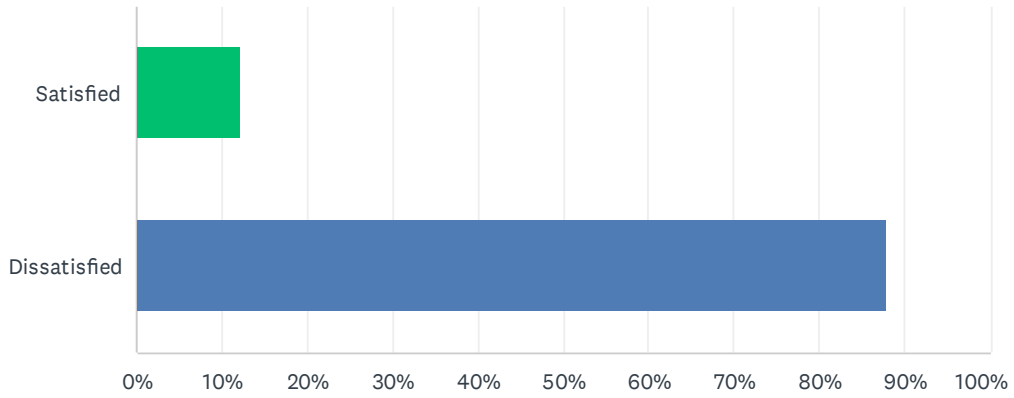

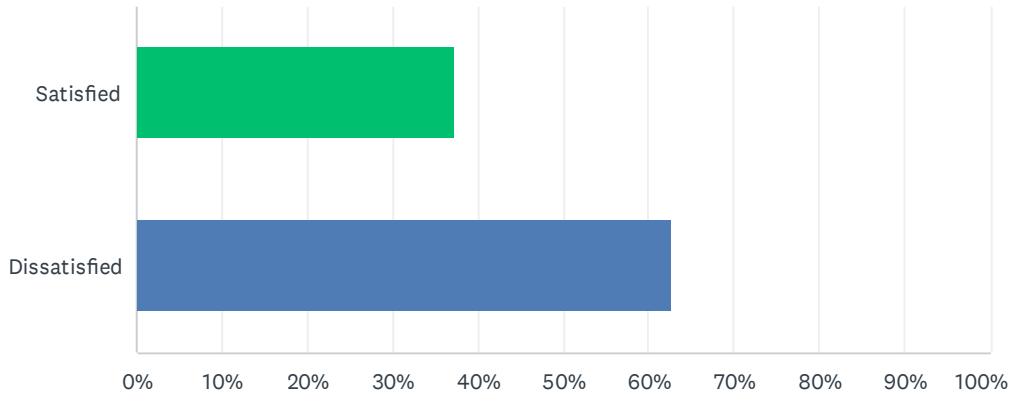

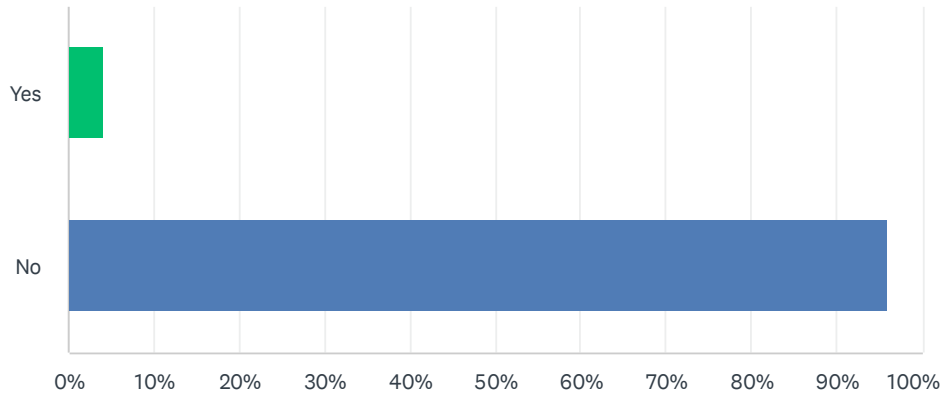
